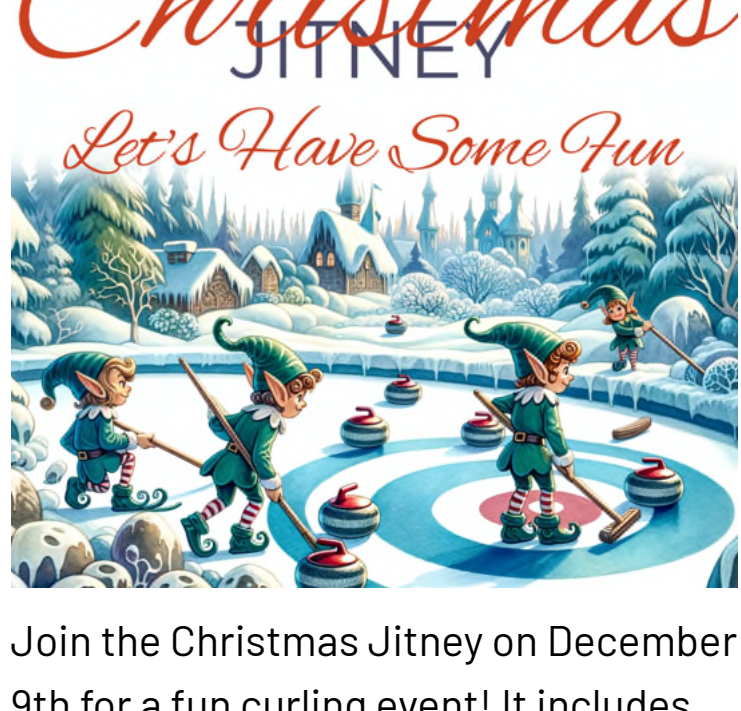

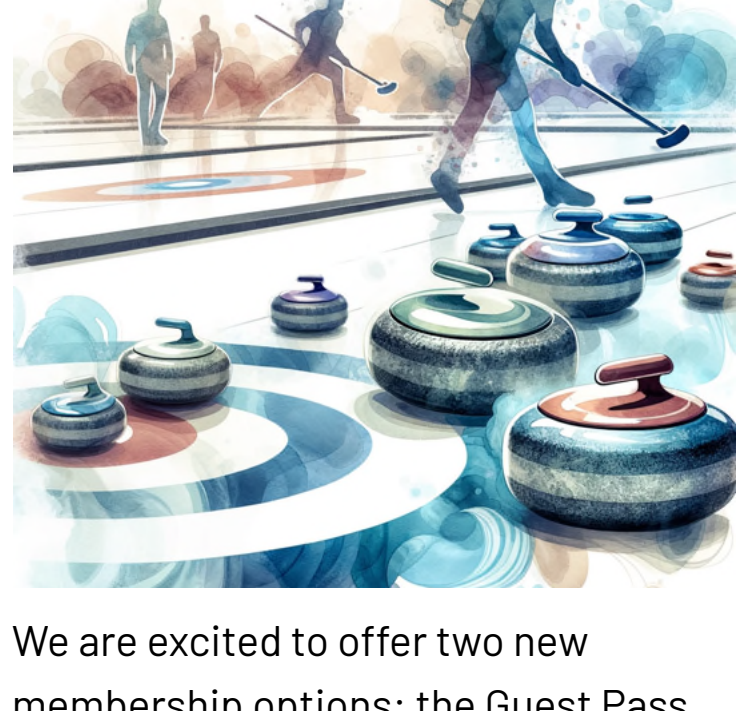
Christmas Jitney

The Craft of Ice

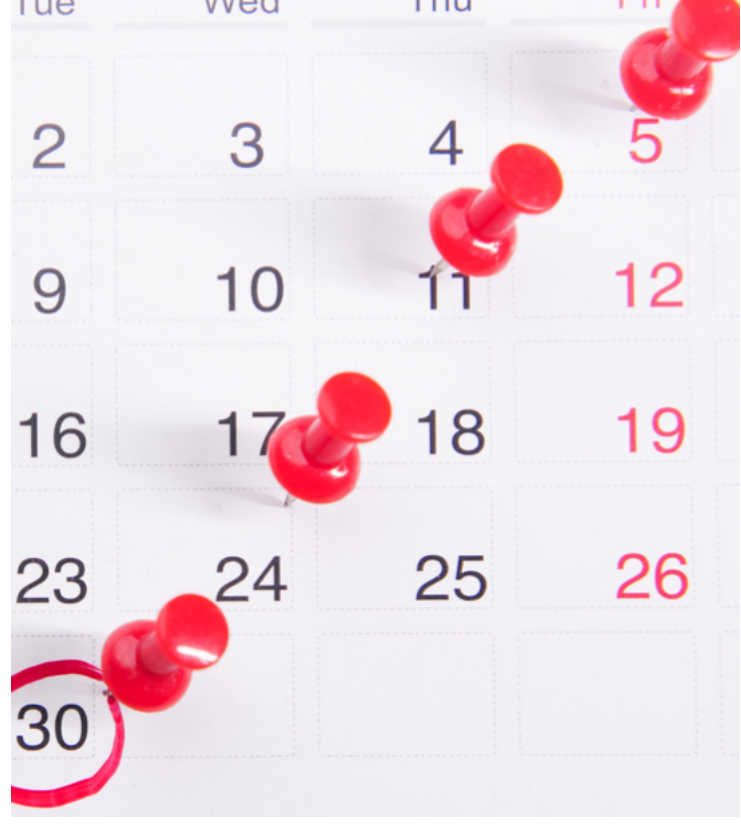
